The workshop is for the purpose of obtaining comments from the public, including representatives of public agencies, private and non-profit organizations, and interested individuals, as the Sediment Master Plan process is being initiated. The Sediment Master Plan is being prepared by the State of California Resources Agency and the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers. The Sediment Master Plan focuses on developing an implementation strategy for integrated, region-wide solutions to sediment management problems. Examples of the issues to be addressed by the Sediment Master Plan are beach erosion and excess sedimentation in coastal wetlands and harbors.
